TCCO has an excellent track record in migrating UNIFACE applications to a higher version. Successfully migrating UNIFACE application depends, in our opinion, on the following **crucial** factors:

- ✓ The **quality of the source code**
- ✓ **Completion of the source code**
- ✓ Dependencies with **obsolete UNIFACE functionality**
- ✓ Dependencies with other applications
- ✓ Dependencies with Database Management Systems-and file management systems

Quality of the source code

The quality of the source code in combination with the **lack/availability** of a robust **error handling** will determine the **migration risk**. In a well-designed, well-documented structure is a bug fix or a replacement of an implementation relatively easy. When a robust error handling system is in place, a bug or obsolete structure can simply be detected through inspecting the UNIFACE log files.

Source code/Dependencies

Is the source code complete? Are the services used in the application still available in the new environment (UNIFACE, Operating System, Database Management System, Services)?

These questions above need an answer before starting a successful migration.

Is migration possible while the shop is open?

TCCO promotes migrations while the shop is open. The open-shop approach avoids a big bang scenario.

We repair/test potential bugs and obsolete structures as much as possible in the current "old" version. After fixing we also test the functionality in the new environment.

Required functionality not available in the new environment will be replaced and tested in the new environment.

The phased TCCO migration approach normally results in a stable process.
